PRODUCT COMPOSITION	Kalamata Olives (72%) [Kalamata Olives, Salt, Vinegar, Vegetable Oil], Canola Oil, Sugar, Garlic, Mixed Herbs, Salt, Citric Acid (330) & Preservative (202, 211).
